generative approach Chomsky & Halle's landmark study Sound Pattern of English (1968) (aka SPE) is the first systematic exposition of generative phonology A key feature was to take seriously the notation in terms of which sounds are represented and rules are formulated

phonology and phonological theory, classic Generative Phonology makes three key assumptions that are relevant to our discussion First is the GENERATIVE assumption that morphemes are stored as underlying representations and that the job of the phonological grammar is to map these underlying representations to surface representations

Generative view of phonology • Hayes 611 – „The morphology of a language places morphemes in different phonological contexts...“ • Different pronunciations of same morpheme can be a source of information about phonology • Not always thought to be the case

Distinctive Feature Theory

Generative Grammar • Each element in the lexicon is stored with details about what features are needed to assemble the necessary phonemes • This is the “underlying representation” • The rules specify how phonemes, morphemes, words, and utterances must be combined to express the idea in a grammatically correct way Generative Phonology
